We are all grateful for the patience and support from everyone who came to pick up food. A huge thanks to our paraprofessionals, lunch staff and many other volunteers who came together today to help distribute meals. Every serving point varied in the number of families who came for food and as a result depending on which location you came to; you may have gotten different amounts of food. It is very difficult to estimate the number of families that will come to pick up food, and we are doing our best so that we can be consistent. We absolutely want to be sure that all our families have enough breakfast and lunch to carry them through until Monday.

As a result, we are going to be distributing breakfasts and lunches this coming Friday, March 20 at Summit Academy North High School, 18601 Middlebelt, Romulus and Summit Academy 30100 Olmstead, Flat Rock from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.

Next week's food delivery dates will be on Monday, March 23 and Wednesday, March 25 from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. We will only be distributing meals at Summit Academy North High School and Summit Academy in Flat Rock. We will no longer be distributing at the bus hubs. Also, we are no longer permitting any students to come into the buildings. This is for everyone's safety. The buildings are being scrubbed from top to bottom and we want to keep them completely sanitized. Our maintenance staff has been working non-stop, and we are grateful for their hard work.
