Please know that the staff has been planning for all possibilities for weeks. Closing for a longer period of time has been one of them Rest assured! We will be ready. We've got this. - YES, students WILL be promoted if they were on track before the school closure.
- Yes, we will continue to serve breakfast and lunch at Summit Academy Flat Rock and Summit Academy North Elementary. Tomorrow, Thursday, April 2 is the next distribution from 11-12.
