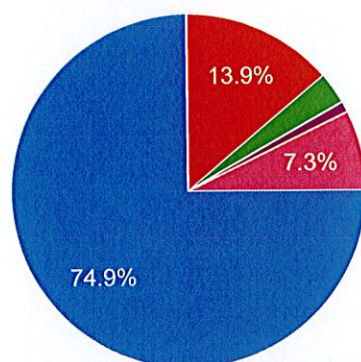

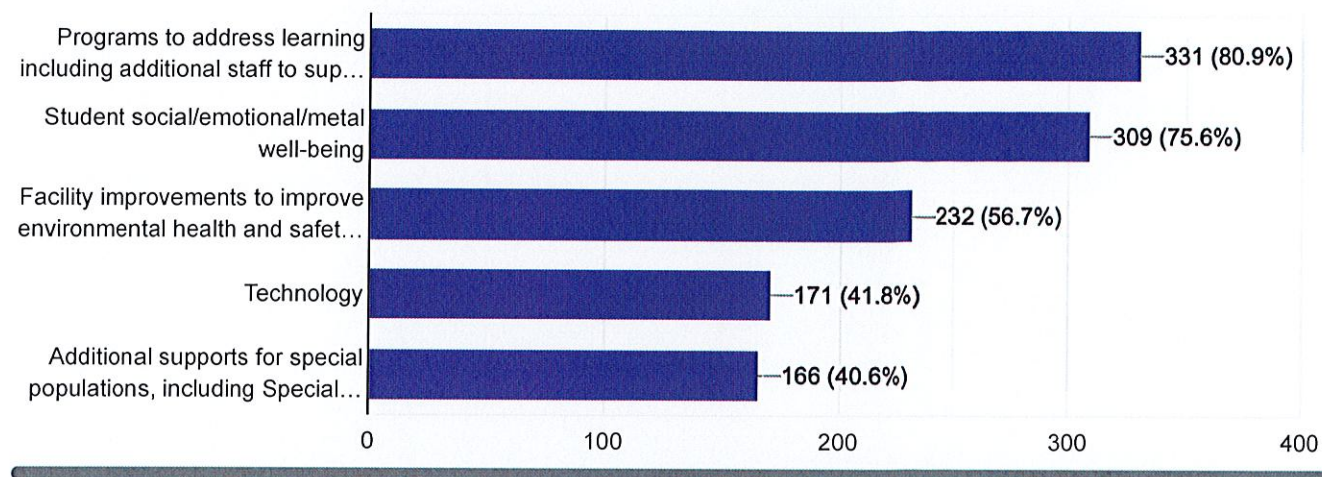

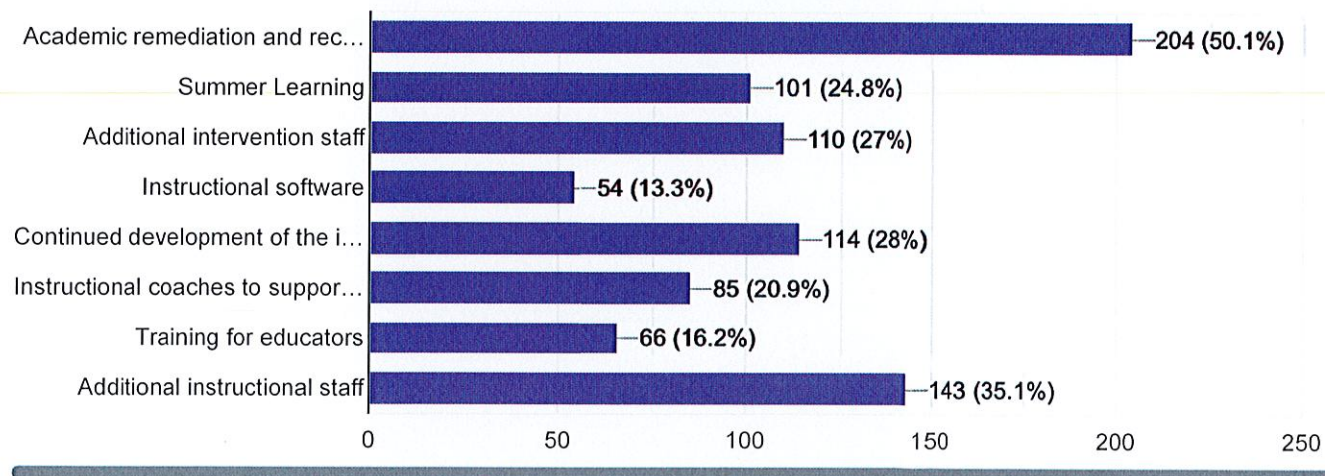
Please select 3 areas below that you believe are the most important priorities as the schools respond to the impact of the COVID-19 Pandemic.

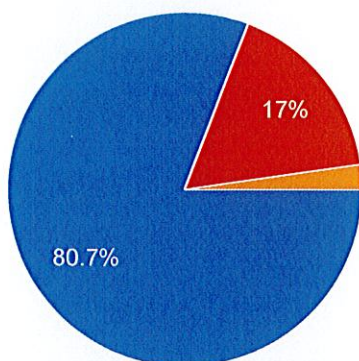
These are difficult choices. I certainly see the value in the options that I didn't select. All of them will help us in the long run.
